HOW TO PLAY PONTOON



PONTOON

Pontoon is a similar game to Blackjack with the added excitement of Bonus payouts and different payout odds. The object of the game is to draw cards with a total closer to 21 than the dealer's total without exceeding 21. Tens (not picture cards) are removed from the decks.

If your first two cards total 21 you have Pontoon or achieve a total of 21 with more than two cards you will win, regardless of the dealer's result, and will be paid the odds as specified in Tables 1 and 2.

The dealer must stand on a hard total of 17 or a soft total of 18.

SURRENDER

If the dealer's first card is a picture or an Ace you may Surrender half your original bet on your first two cards. If the dealer does not achieve Pontoon, the dealer will only collect half of your original bet.

DOUBLING

You may Double your original bet on any hand made up of 2 or more cards, except 21, by placing an additional bet up to the value of your original bet. You will then receive only one additional card to that hand.

An ace in the first two cards of any double always has a point value of 1 not 11.

If the dealer achieves Pontoon only the original bet is taken by the dealer. If after doubling, your total is less than 21 and you are dissatisfied with your total you may Forfeit your original bet but retain the double portion.

If you place additional bets by Doubling and the dealer achieves Pontoon the dealer will only take your original bet.

Winning doubled hands shall be paid at odds of 1 to 1 and not be eligible for payout odds and Super Bonus as described in Tables 1 and 2.

SPLITTING PAIRS

If your first two cards are identical in value you may split them by placing an additional bet equal to your original bet. You may split twice to form a maximum of three hands except for Aces which you can only split once. If you split Aces or Picture cards you cannot achieve Pontoon.

INSURANCE

When the dealer's first card is an Ace you may insure your bet, up to half your original bet, against the dealer making Pontoon immediately after you receive your second card.

SUPER BONUS

If you have three suited sevens and the dealer's first card is any seven you will win the Super Bonus as set out in Table 2. The Super Bonus will not apply if the hands have been split or doubled. All other original wagers, winning or losing on that round of play, will receive a Bonus Payment of \$50.
